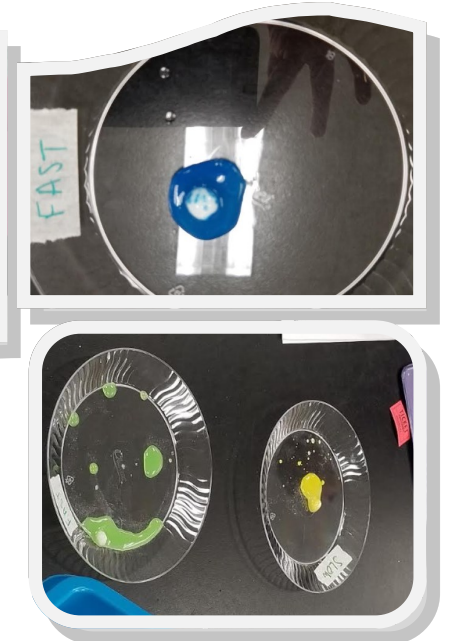


NMS students share kind and encouraging messages with one another in the girls' cafeteria bathroom as part of the kindness challenge. How are you spreading kindness in NMS?
